Eligibility Criteria

Follow the required eligibility criteria for UG, PG, Diploma, and PhD Engineering courses for candidates:

BE/BTech: Must have passed Class 12 with Physics, Chemistry, and Mathematics as core subjects and a minimum 60 per cent aggregate score.

BTech Lateral Entry: One must have a three-year diploma granted by the Board of Technical Examination of a state government with a minimum of 45%.

ME/MTech: need a BE/BTech degree with a valid score in the GATE exam.

Diploma: must have a Class 10 or equivalent certificate with at least 35 percent in science and math subjects

PhD: should have a BTech, MTech, or a minimum of 55 percent aggregate
